

## THE ACTIONS

- Capitalization of the best international practices on biodiversity protection in order to promote local / traditional products.
- Analysis of local contexts and preparation of guidelines for development and agro-biodiversity protection policies.
- Mapping of the varieties of local plants and native species and evaluation of the identified products.
- Training and technical assistance to Local Authorities for the definition of action plans aimed to the conservation of rural diversity.
- Activation of networks, "usinas" (discussion forum) and laboratories as places for discussion and elaboration for public, economic and social actors of the involved territories in order to identify and propose policies and measures to support the protection and promotion of agro-biodiversity .
- Interventions of protection and promotion of local varieties, with a potential for development, through technical assistance to producers' communities.
- Dissemination of acquired knowledge on selected productions and organization of food education interventions to promote the consumption of local products.
- Comparison on the best practices for the protection of agro-biodiversity and exchange of experiences between the Brazilians, Angolans and Mozambicans partners.

## WHAT IS G.L.O.B. PROJECT

Local Governance  
for biodiversity

It is a project of international cooperation, co-funded by the European Commission through the General Directorate Europeaid that is responsible for implementing the European policy of international cooperation and development throughout the world and for offering humanitarian aid.

### WHERE

Glob operates in Latin America and Africa, in three Portuguese-speaking Countries: State of Bahia in Brazil, metropolitan area of Maputo in Mozambique and Province of Namibe in Angola.

### WHY G.L.O.B. PROJECT

The project is mainly addressed to the Local Authorities of the beneficiary countries in order to trigger or to strengthen a process of growth both in the elaboration and in the implementation of public policies that promote sustainable development, preservation and enhancement of rural diversity of the areas involved. Glob is based on a strategy of broad involvement and interaction among all actors - publics, socials and economics - in order to increase the abilities of public policies to answer the needs of the territory, with particular reference to the actors of the food chain.

The ultimate aim of this development process, promoted by GLOB, is to improve the standard of living of the populations and to reduce social vulnerability of small producers. The geographical and context differences of the three areas of intervention also allow opportunities for exchanging experiences between Africa, Latin America and Europe.
